Applicant	Amount Awarded	Brief Note
Over the Rainbow Theatre Group	€600.00	To facilitate personal development for participants and set the seeds for the development of more LGBT drama groups in Ireland
Limerick Pride Committee	€500.00	In 2011 Limerick Pride will be marking a decade of LGBT visibility & awareness raising in the Mid west. To mark this milestone- to move to a high profile, local venue for post parade celebration, with wheelchair accessibility and ISL interpretation
GoBLLeT LGBT Ballina	€1,500.00	To develop inclusion for new members, strengthen local LGBT networks by inviting their participation, and become better equipped to facilitate members' personal needs by learning about their mental and physical disability issues
Cork Gay Community Development Company Ltd	€1,000.00	"UP" Cork Youth project supports and resources LGBTQ young people aged 15-23 to make informed decisions which affect their lives. To provide activities; Expression through Music/Rapping Project, Personal Development through Drama, Hip Hop, Graffiti Art

LGBT Pride Northwest	€1,000.00	To increase genuine accessibility and participation in NW Pride & other local LGBT events through a 2-day forum 'Full Spectrum'. Shared consultation will explore access/inclusion, Training in disability awareness & ISL & collaboration on inclusive events
Donegal Youth Service Ltd	€3,000.00	To provide LGBT awareness training throughout schools in Donegal; target 10 schools over a 3 month period, which will provide an opportunity for young people in the county to engage with LGBT issues. Service does not currently have the capacity to do so
Belong To Dublin	€2,500.00	National residential for LGBT youth (18–23yo) to develop their capacity in advocacy and activism. This shall be conducted through collaborative peer education and facilitated workshops in a fun and diverse manner that will aid team building and leadership
