Amach Wicklow	€1,500.00	Co Wicklow	To counteract the isolation experienced by LGBT people in rural areas; organise a series of workshops in parts of Wicklow not currently served. Topics will include Civil Partnership, Coming Out and Bullying, LGBT and Ageing, Friends of LGBT People etc. Grant is to develop a Joint Strategy with Gay Bray (€3,000 between both)
Ballina Family Resource Centre	€1,000.00	Co Mayo	To enact GoBLet's short-term development plan, specifically to provide information support through speakers and host a health Information Event for the group, family and friends, to attend training and seminars to enhance capacity

Dunmanway Family Resource Centre	€1,000.00	Co Cork	Facilitated support group for LGBT people for 20 weeks. The aim of the group will be developed by participants but it is likely to include; provision of safe and supportive environment, break down stigma and isolation, discrimination, awareness. Grant is a Contribution for facilitator. To establish a model of LGBT support group
Gay Bray	€1,500.00	Co Wicklow	Plans to arrange an outreach service, along with carrying out research and needs analysis on the area Grant is to develop a Joint Strategy with Amach Wicklow (€3,000 between both)
GayWestmeath	€1,000.00	Co Westmeath	To strengthen the committee's foundations by taking part in a programme of committee skills training, community leadership, listening skills and team building exercises. This will help it to begin providing a support service to local LGBT community. Grant is contribution for Team Building Residential
Kerry LGBT Project Ciarrai Amach formerly Kerry Gay Lesbian Project	€2,500.00	Co Kerry	To train LGBT members in equality and diversity issues. It would be pre development/capacity building in orientation helping the community to develop from within. Once trained Ambassadors would adopt a train the trainer type approach. Grant is a Contribution to develop the Ambassador Strategy
LGBT Lawyers Association of Ireland(LGBTLAI)	€2,000.00	Dublin 2	Seed funding to support the development stage and build upon work already done; assist stocking of resource library in free legal aid service, To enhance and complete work on website, Development of information leaflet, contribute to hosting of seminar
LGBT Pride Northwest	€900.00	Co Leitrim	A collaborative action to explore ways to record the experience, working processes and ethics of NW Pride and Galway Community Pride in such a way that this information can be sourced and used by other groups
LGBTinC (Cavan)	€1,000.00	Co Louth	To engage a trainer/ facilitator for residential weekend. To design and print and information leaflet to advertise the group , advertise in local media, and a budget for communication. Grant is Contribution to get group known/ publicity
LGBTsynergy	€1,000.00	Co Dublin	Technology training for older LGBT people– how to use the internet, a mobile phone and Skype. This is a 10 week training project for 10 individuals with a number of indicators and outcomes.
LOOK - Loving Our Out Kids - formerly Parents Support	€4,000.00	Dublin 5	To establish and coordinate regular nationwide parents meetings. Funding is required to pay a coordinator for a limited time to get groups off the ground, visit remote areas and establish the network. Grant is to formulate a National Response for parents

Moville Men's Group	€500.00	Co Donegal	To produce, launch and distribute a LGBT Resource list (books, DVDs, websites, phonedlines, supports and organisations) through Donegal libraries, Family Centres, Youth settings and Schools. List and launch will be in conjunction with LGBT Diversity. Grant is a Contribution to develop a template for use elsewhere
Tipperary Regional Youth Service	€1,000.00	Co Tipperary	Information seminar in order to tackle the lack of understanding of LGBT young people in the wider rural community. To provide answers for family members, LGBT young people, create positive awareness in the wider community
Youth Work Ireland	€1,700.00	Co Galway	Parenting programme for parents of LGBT young people to cover topics such as Coming Out, Spousal issues, Listening to another Parent, Fears. To allow parents to discuss common feelings and issues that arise
